Creating a Safety Net

A two-year, \$50,000 commitment helped establish a Community-Based Services (CBS) Emergency Relief Fund for individuals with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (I/DD). The fund provides a vital safety net during times of unexpected financial hardship, helping cover essential needs that traditional funding sources often cannot.

100+ Lives Impacted

More than 100 individuals have received emergency assistance so far through the fund. Support has included access to food, emergency housing, educational resources, and other critical needs. In one instance, two sisters received laptops for homeschooling that they could not otherwise afford, allowing them to continue learning and stay connected with others outside the home.

Contributed to youth programs, healthy living initiatives, and family services strengthening neighborhoods across Western New York.



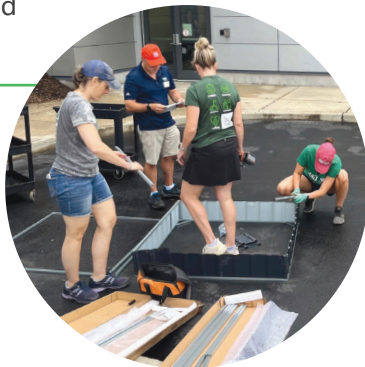
